Gear List for Dorado Fishing in Corrientes

Fly Fishing Gear

Rods: Two medium-fast action rods, 7 and 8 weights, 9 ft.

Lines: Floating and shooting lines, anything similar to: SA Ultra 4 Heavy Freshwater/Bass and SA Ultra 4 Wet Tip, Type II or III

Leaders: SA Master series toothy critter wire leaders, or saltwater tapered leaders 20 lb tippet.

Mono Tippets: 20 yard spools of 15, 20 and 25 lb.

Wire leaders: American Fishing Line, Surflon wire leader 20 lb. 1x7

Breathable waders and booties with wading boots

Wading belt

Polarized sunglasses

Pliers, hook sharpener, clippers.

Please do not bring or use a Boga-Grip

Flies

Deer hair and feathered streamers about 4-8 inch tied on 3/0-5/0 stainless steel hooks.

Deceivers work well but flies can be a variety of high volume streamers in colors black, purple, chartreuse, white, yellow, brown, green, red and pink. Also saltwater poppers and divers work well.

Conventional Gear

7 ft medium fast casting or spinning rod, 20 lb line.

Hard plastic, floating to deep diving crankbaits, in a variety of colors, 3-6 inches long. Common makers are: Yo-Zuri, Heddon and Rapala.

Clothing (Temperatures - Dec 85, Jan-Feb 95-100, Mar 80-90 Apr-May 60-75, Jun-Jul 45-55 Aug 40-50, Sept 45-55, Oct, 55-60. Nights are 15 degrees cooler)

Warm humid weather clothing

Sun protective clothing

Sun and rain hat and rain gear

Windbreaker/Fleece jacket

Comfortable walking shoes, boat shoes (I.e. tennis shoes, canvas shoes or hiking boots)

Sturdy waterproof sandals are also very versatile and comfortable but tend to catch on fly line easily.

Other

Strong sunscreen, lip protection
